None appeared on behalf of petitioner, however Mr Sumeet Kumar appeared on behalf of respondent and Mr Ajay Kumar appeared on behalf of Him Education Society Dharmpur, Solan. During hearing respondent Sumeet Kumar gave statement on oath that his Institute started tally and NTT Course in the year 2021 and for which franchisee was taken from the Him Education Society Dharmpur, Solan, HP. He further stated that they started NTT course to help the students to get employment in private schools and no where any gurantee was given to any student that they will get employment in Govt. sector through our NTT course and his institute has closed the NTT course in 2023 and never intended to start the NTT course to defraud any student of institution.</p> <p>Further, Mr Ajay Kumar, owner of Him Education and Research Society from whom respondent institute took authorisation for conducting the NTT course also gave statement on oath that his society was registered under HP Co-Operative Society Act and through this Society they used to conduct various computer courses and NTT course and further authorised other institututes to conduct the same courses. He further stated that NTT course was conducted only to help the students to get employment in Private School and never gave any assurance/gurantee of employment in Govt. sector. Moreover, his Society closed all the courses after the academic session of 2022-2023.</p>	



		<p>In view of the submissions made by both the parties and on further perusal of complaint and statements made before the Commission. It is hereby observes that the respondent never assured any student regarding getting Govt. employment through NTT Diploma and the students were very much clear about the terms and conditions at the time of taking admission in the institute.
